
### **HIGHLIGHTS FOR FY 2021:**

- The Extractive Sector contribution to the **GDP of Guyana was GYD 704.94 billion** which is equivalent to **44.78%** of the total **GYD 1,574.10 billion**.
- The Extractive Sector contribution to Government's Revenue was GYD 134.68 billion which is equivalent to 45.54% of the total GYD 295.76 billion.
- The Extractive Sector contribution to **Export Revenues was GYD 839.76 billion** which is equivalent to **89.36%** of the total **GYD 939.79 billion**.
- The Extractive Sector accounted for 44,620 persons being employed, which is equivalent to **18.07%** of the total **246,881 persons** that were employed.



### Contribution of the Extractive Sector to Guyana's Economy Fiscal Year (FY) 2021


#### **CONTRIBUTION TO GDP FOR FY 2021**



#### GDP:

- Guyana's GDP for FY 2021 was **GYD 1,574.10** billion.
- The Extractive Sector contribution to the GDP of Guyana was **GYD 704.94 billion** which is equivalent to **44.78%** of it.
- The Oil and Gas Sector together with the Mining Sector accounted for **GYD 681.58 billion** which is equivalent to **43.3%**.


#### CONTRIBUTION TO GOVERNMENT REVENUES FOR FY 2021



#### **Revenues:**

- Total Government Revenue for FY 2021 was
  **GYD 295.76 billion**.
- The Extractive Sector contribution to Government's Revenue was **GYD 134.68 billion** which is equivalent to **45.54**% of it.
- The Oil and Gas Sector together with the Mining Sector accounted for **GYD 133.35 billion** which is equivalent to **45.08**%.


## CONTRIBUTION TO EXPORTS FOR FY 2021



#### **Export:**

- The total Export Revenues for FY 2021 was **GYD 939.79 billion**.
- The Extractive Sector contribution to Export Revenues was GYD 839.76 billion which is equivalent to 89.36% of it.
- The Oil and Gas together with the Mining Sector accounted for **GYD 825.48 billion** which is equivalent to **87.84**%.

#### CONTRIBUTION TO EMPLOYMENT FOR FY 2021




#### **Employment:**

- A total of **246,881 persons** were employed in Guyana in FY 2021.
- The Extractive Sector accounted for 44,620 persons being employed, which is equivalent to 18.07%.
- The Forestry Sector accounted for the highest employment with **23,669 (9.59%)** followed by Mining with **12,344 (5%)**.



### Contribution of the Extractive Sector to Guyana's Economy Fiscal Year (FY) 2020


#### **CONTRIBUTION TO GDP FOR FY 2020**



#### GDP:

- Guyana's GDP for FY 2020 was **GYD 1,060.04** billion.
- The Extractive Sector contribution to the GDP of Guyana was **GYD 329.96 billion** which is equivalent to **31.13%** of it.
- The Oil and Gas together with the Mining Sector accounted for GYD 309.2 billion which is equivalent to 29.17%.


#### CONTRIBUTION TO GOVERNMENT REVENUES FOR FY 2020



#### **Revenues:**

- Total Government Revenue for FY 2020 was
  **GYD 250.98 billion**.
- The Extractive Sector contribution to Government's Revenue was **GYD 93.78 billion** which is equivalent to **37.37%** of it.
- The Oil and Gas together with the Mining Sector accounted for **GYD 92.2 billion** which is equivalent to **36.74**%.


## CONTRIBUTION TO EXPORTS FOR FY 2020



**Export:** 

- The total Export Revenues for FY 2020 was GYD 556.99 billion.
- The Extractive Sector contribution to Export Revenues was **GYD 471.72 billion** which is equivalent to **84.69%** of it.
- The Oil and Gas together with the Mining Sector accounted for GYD 451.66 billion which is equivalent to 81.09%.

#### CONTRIBUTION TO EMPLOYMENT FOR FY 2020




#### **Employment:**

- A total of 264,862 persons were employed in Guyana in FY 2020.
- The Extractive Sector accounted for 40,953 persons being employed, which is equivalent to 15.46%.
- The Forestry Sector accounted for the highest employment with **23,669 (8.94%)** followed by Mining with **8,677 (3.28%)**.

## **Contribution of the Extractive Sector to Guyana's GDP for FY 2020 versus FY 2021:**


- The **Oil and Gas Sector** contributed an additional **GYD 369.74 billion** towards the **GDP in FY 2021** which represented an increase of **204.97**% when compared to **FY 2020**.
- The Mining Sector contributed an additional GYD 2.64 billion towards the GDP in FY 2021 which represented an increase of 2.05% when compared to FY 2020.
- The Forestry Sector contributed an additional GYD 3.94 billion towards the GDP in FY 2021 which represented an increase of 42.32% when compared to FY 2020.
- The Fisheries Sector contributed GYD 10.11 billion towards the GDP in FY 2021 which represented a decrease of GYD 1.34 billion (11.70%) when compared to FY 2020.
- Altogether, the Extractive Sector contributed an additional GYD 374.98 billion towards the GDP in FY 2021 which represented an increase of 113.64% when compared to FY 2020.





### Contribution of the Extractive Sector to Government's Revenue for FY 2020 versus FY 2021

#### **CONTRIBUTION TO REVENUE FOR FY 2020 AND FY 2021**




#### **Contribution of the Extractive Sector to Government's Revenue for FY 2020** versus FY 2021:

- The Oil and Gas Sector contributed an additional GYD 46.33 billion towards the Government's Revenue in FY 2021 which represented an increase of 70.38% when compared to FY 2020.
- The Mining Sector contributed GYD 21.19 billion towards the Government Revenue in FY 2021 which represented a decrease of GYD 5.18 billion (19.64%) when compared to FY 2020.
- The Forestry Sector contributed GYD 1.18 billion towards the Government Revenue in FY 2021 which represented a decrease of GYD 0.06 billion (4.84%) when compared to FY 2020.
- The Fisheries Sector contributed GYD 0.15 billion towards the Government Revenue in FY 2021 which represented a decrease of GYD 0.19 billion (55.88%) when compared to FY 2020.
- Altogether, the Extractive Sector contributed an additional GYD 40.9 billion towards the Government Revenue in FY 2021 which represented an increase of 43.61% when compared to FY 2020.

### **Contribution of the Extractive Sector to Total Exports for FY 2020 versus FY 2021**

**CONTRIBUTION TO TOTAL EXPORTS FOR FY 2020 AND FY 2021** 



## **Contribution of the Extractive Sector to Total Exports for FY 2020 versus FY 2021:**

- The **Oil and Gas Sector** contributed an additional **GYD 392.17 billion** towards **Total Exports in FY 2021** which represented an increase of **171.19%** when compared to **FY 2020**.
- The Mining Sector contributed GYD 204.23 billion towards Total Exports in FY 2021 which represented a decrease of GYD 18.35 billion (8.24%) when compared to FY 2020.
- The Forestry Sector contributed GYD 5.72 billion towards Total Exports in FY 2021 which represented a decrease of GYD 0.23 billion (3.87%) when compared to FY 2020.
- The Fisheries Sector contributed GYD 8.56 billion towards Total Exports in FY 2021 which represented a decrease of GYD 5.55 billion (39.33%) when compared to FY 2020.
- Altogether, the Extractive Sector contributed an additional GYD 368.04 billion towards Total Exports in FY 2021 which represented an increase of 78.02% when compared to FY 2020.

## Summary Contributions of the Extractive Sector to Guyana's Economy for FY 2020 versus FY 2021:

- **GDP Increased** by an additional **GYD 374.98 billion (113.64%)** in **FY 2021** when compared to **FY 2020**.
- **Government's Revenue Increased** by an additional **GYD 40.9 billion (43.61%)** in **FY 2021** when compared to **FY 2020**.
- Export Increased by an additional GYD 368.04 billion (78.02%) in FY 2021 when compared to FY 2020.

#### **CONTRIBUTION TO EMPLOYMENT FOR FY 2020 AND FY 2021**


## **Contribution of the Extractive Sector to Employment for FY 2020 versus FY 2021:**

- With respect to employment in the Oil and Gas Sector in 2020 and 2021, data collection methods did not allow for measuring indirect employment. However, this will be included in all other reports moving forward.
- No changes were observed with respect to **Employment** within the **Forestry** and **Fisheries Sectors** as **was reported** by the **Independent Administrator**.
- In the Mining Sector, an additional 3,667 persons were employed in FY 2021 when compared to FY 2020 and this represents a 42.26% increase.
- Altogether, the Extractive Sector contributed towards 44,620 persons being employed in FY 2021 which represents an 8.95% increase when compared to FY 2020 which saw 40,953 persons being employed.

#### NOTE:

- In FY 2020, a total of 264,862 persons were employed in Guyana versus 246,881 in FY 2021 which represented a 6.79% decrease.
- This decrease in total employment was because of the COVID-19 Pandemic.
- All Sectors except for **Oil and Gas** includes **direct** and **indirect** employment figures.

### Percentage Contribution of each Sector to Employment for FY 2020 versus FY 2021



#### Percentage Contribution of each Sector to Employment for FY 2020 versus FY 2021

The **Forestry Sector** accounted for the **highest** number of persons **employed** within the Extractive Sector:

- **57.80%** of total persons employed within the Extractive Sector in **FY 2020**.
- **53.05%** of total persons employed within the Extractive Sector in **FY 2021**.

The **Mining Sector** accounted for the **second highest** number of persons employed within the Extractive Sector:

- **21.19%** of total persons employed within the Extractive Sector in **FY 2020**.
- **27.66%** of total persons employed within the Extractive Sector in **FY 2021**.

The **Fisheries Sector** accounted for the **third highest** number of persons employed within the Extractive Sector:

- **20.42%** of total persons employed within the Extractive Sector in **FY 2020**.
- **18.74%** of total persons employed within the Extractive Sector in **FY 2021**.

The **Oil and Gas Sector** accounted for the **lowest number of persons directly employed** within the Extractive Sector with **0.60%** in **FY 2020** and **0.55%** in **FY 2021**. Figures from **indirect employment** were **not reported** on in **past FY Reports** for the **Oil and Gas Sector but** will be made available for **all Reports moving forward**.
