1. Call to Order and Welcome at 10:00 HRS

A quorum was established and the Chair called the meeting to order at 10:00hrs welcoming everyone inclusive of the new civil society representative in attendance - Ms. Denise De Souza.

4. MINUTES OF THE 69th MSG – consideration and Adoption.

The Minutes was adopted by Mr. William Thompson (I) and seconded by Hema Khan (G).

5. Review of draft FY 2021 Report.

The IA Consultant submitted the draft FY 2021 Report on Wednesday, December 6, 2023. The IA Consultant presented an overview of the Draft Report to the MSG. The draft report was accepted by the MSG. A schedule of engagements for the review was agreed to as follow:

The key findings and recommendations pointed to the challenges in the preparation of the report including the deficiencies at the State entities level where timely, organized and data at the disaggregated levels are not available. This pointed to the inherent deficiencies across most agencies.

The Audit Assurance is incorporated in section 5 of the Report.

Section 3- Contextual section was already reviewed by the MSG. The IA Consultant, in keeping with its remit is expected to finalized based on data collected. The GYEITI Secretariat will continue to support any future requests of the IA Consultant.

6. Reports from MSG Committees

- (i) Co- Chairs met with World Bank Consultant Mr. Sam Tokpah and addressed a number of issues that he is working on inclusive of the beneficial Ownership and Systematic Disclosure (Mainstreaming) Terms of Reference.
- (ii) <u>IA Committee</u>: As the lead Committee with oversight for the preparation of the FY 2021 Report, the Committee continues to meet on a weekly basis on more than one occasions and as necessary to track progress on the IA Consultant work and review of submissions received from the IA Consultant.

(iii) <u>Workplan, MSG -TOR and Validation Committee.</u>

The Committee met on December 7, 2023. Three TOR was examined and recommended for the MSG consideration. These are:

- (a) **Workplan for FY 2024**: This was considered by the Validation and Workplan Committee and was recommended for MSG approval.
- (b) **TOR on Extractives Beneficial Ownership Transparency in Guyana**. The validation and Workplan Committee recommended MSG approval subject to the adjustment of the timelines for the deliverables.

(c) **Terms of Reference for the Mainstreaming Feasibility Study**: Subject to the change in the title of the document and appropriate adjustments in the content to reflect the term used in the Standard, i.e., Systematic Disclosure - the Committee recommended the MSG approval.

(iv) Communication and Outreach Committee:

This Committee met on December 7,2023 and focused on the development of the new website.
