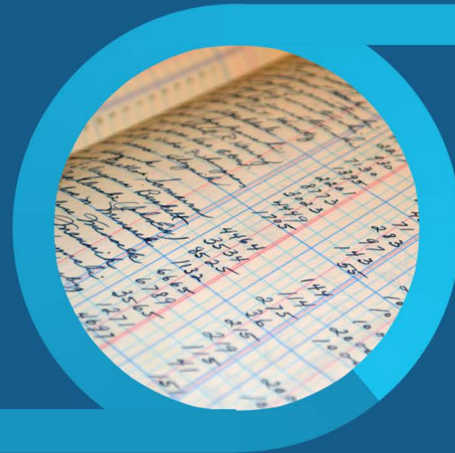
# BUILDING TRANSPARENCY IN NATURAL RESOURCES



## What We Expect from EITI Supporting Companies

- Publicly declare support for the EITI and champion transparency initiatives
- Disclose comprehensive data in line with EITI Standards across all implementing countries where you operate
- Report all taxes and payments made to governments in EITI implementing countries
- Disclose volumes purchased and payments made for oil, gas, and minerals from governments
- Provide audited financial statements for public review
- Publicly disclose beneficial owners to ensure accountability
- Implement rigorous due diligence processes and publish an anti-corruption policy
- Support disclosure of future licenses and contracts to promote openness
- Publish commitments on gender diversity to advance inclusive practices

- **Enhance governance and accountability** in both public and private sectors
- **Provide essential data** that informs smart policymaking and public debate

## HOW THE EITI CREATES REAL IMPACT

### Driving Change Through Local Leadership and Collaboration

The EITI works at the grassroots level where it matters most:

- **National implementation through** local multi-stakeholder groups (MSGs) that ensure programs align with each country's unique priorities and needs
- **Community-driven oversight** where MSGs take ownership of publishing, analyzing, and communicating EITI data to broader audiences
- **Informed decision-making** as stakeholders and citizens use transparent data to strengthen governance, fuel public debate, and drive inclusive development
